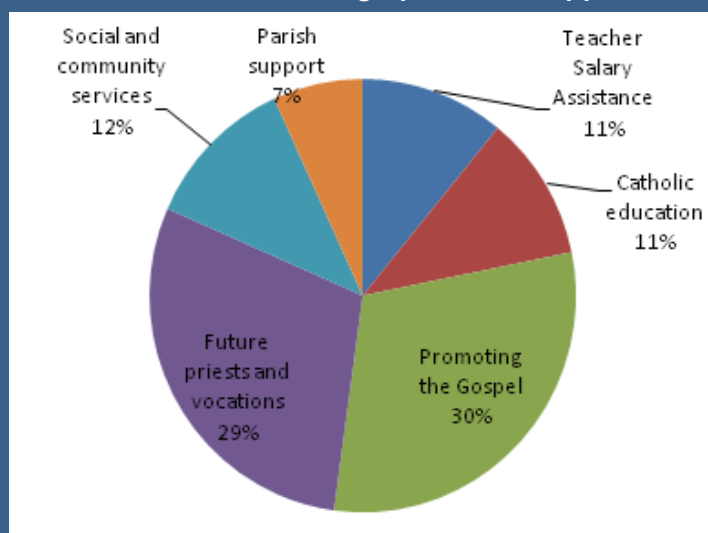

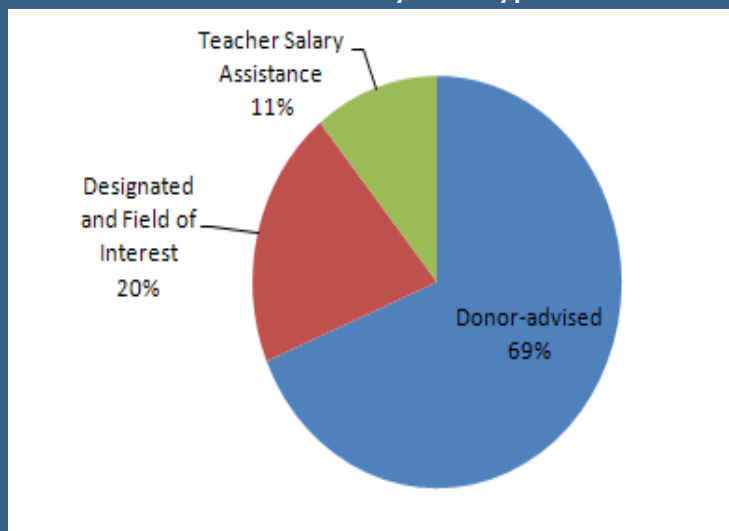
Portfolio Return: 12.70%

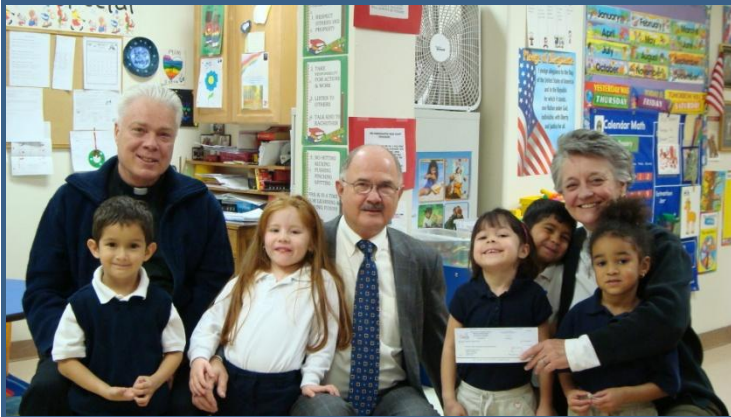
